MARC Board Meeting Minutes

MARC Board Meeting

November 9, 2010

Board members present: Steve KD3WK, Steve WA2EAJ, Allan AB3FN, Dieter K3DK, Bob N3JIZ, Lou WX3I, Jim W3DCL, Dennis K3DS, Miguel KC2HMG, Gerry W3GER

President Steve KD3WK called the meeting to order at 7:38 PM.

Treasurer Lou WX3I rendered his report: The current bank balance is \$11,239.74. Cash on hand \$516.47. It may be possible to eliminate the \$63.60 monthly rental for the storage locker (see further below).

A plaque was awarded to **Dieter K3DK** in recognition of his outstanding recent service as President.

Regarding tax status, it is believed that the club once had 501(c)(4) status, but it is unclear whether this still holds. A CPA will be contacted to check into the matter.

Regarding the archive, Kay N3KN is in the process of sending archival material to Steve KD3WK. A meeting with Marlene WA3UOC was postponed because of a death in Marlene's family.

Dennis K3DS provided cost information (invoices) for the new repeater equipment, and insurance will be promptly obtained. probably through the ARRL, at an estimated cost of approximately \$100/yr.

There have been problems with the website ISP forwarding email sent through @marc-radio.org. At least some of these problems have been cleared up in a telephone consultation between the ISP and Dieter K3DK. Gerry W3GER will investigate whether any problems remain.

The club's storage shed is a significant expense, which may be possible to eliminate. Dennis K3DS will be able to store some of the long items (masts, push-up poles, etc.). Other contents of the shed can probably be discarded or distributed. A workday will be scheduled at the shed to attend to these matters.

The Holiday party will be held at the Uno Chicago Grill in Newtown Square. They offer a variety of "party platters" of which it was agreed we would purchase one of each variety for a total cost \$539.28 (incl. gratuity and tax). Diners will select food buffet-style from these party platters. The party will be subsidized about 50%-- a member and one guest can attend for \$10/person; additional guests or non-members can attend for the estimated full price of \$20/person. Gerry W3GER will notify the membership ASAP. Payment must be received by Saturday, November 27.

It has recently been determined that the 147.06 repeater antenna, now 18 years old, resonates at 155 MHz. An expenditure of \$500 has been tentatively approved for a replacement.

New MARC Yahoo Group

MARC has created a new Yahoo group. Yahoo Groups work like a bulletin board system. Messages may be posted to the bulletin board and all subscribers may read and reply to the message. The MARC Yahoo Group is for members of the Mid-Atlantic Amateur Radio Club. The purpose of this group is to foster communications between and to distribute information to club members. Posts about ham radio related items 'For Sale' and 'Wanted' may be posted to this group. However, commercial ads are not allowed. MARC accepts no responsibility for any transactions resulting from 'For Sale' or 'Wanted' ads posted to this group. The group is moderated, meaning that the moderators must approve requests for membership to this Yahoo group. Group members may choose to receive posts via email or by the website only.

Earlier in December, members received a pre-approved invitation to join this Yahoo Group. In order to join, members should have a Yahoo account. If you don't already have one, a free account can be created. There are several options to receive messages posted to the group. You can receive individual emails for each message posted to the group, a single daily digest email containing all the messages posted to the group the previous day, or only special messages from the group. You can also use the Yahoo Groups website to read and reply to group messages. Emails sent to group members are sent to the email address you setup when you join the MARC Yahoo Group.

By using this Yahoo Group, members can communicate with other subscribed MARC members without having to use the MARC mailing lists, which need board member approval. Yahoo Groups also allows subscribers to post files, links and photos to the group. The MARC mailing lists will continue to be the primary way the club communicates with its members. This Yahoo Group is a secondary communications tool.

To join the MARC Yahoo Group, go to: http://groups.yahoo.com/groups/marc-radio

Click on the "Join This Group!" button. If you aren't already logged into your Yahoo account, you will be asked to log in. Since the Group is moderated, your request for membership must be approved by one of the group moderators. If you are

a current or former MARC member or a friend of MARC, you will probably be approved. We hope you will choose to join this new group and make use of all that is offered.

MARC CW Key Building Challenge (Part 2)

At the October 19, 2010 meeting, **Steve WA2EAJ**, introduced the CW Key Building Challenge. **Jari Vainio**, **OH6DC** has a website showing many weird and wacky CW keys he has built out of everyday items like neck ties, speed skates, paper cups, nail clippers, bananas and many more. His website shows how they are built and includes a short video of the keys in operation. These keys are really very funny. Here is the URL to his site:

Steve WA2EAJ presented part 2 of the MARC CW Key Building Challenge at the November 16, 2010 meeting. Three homemade keys were shown. Mike KF3CD showed us his work glove CW key. Metal grommets were placed at the tips of the thumb and index finger. Tapping these fingers together keyed the code practice oscillator. Steve WA2EAJ showed his QSL card CW key. Two old QSL cards were stapled together at one end and the other end had paper clips connected to the lead wires and were separated by weather stripping. You pressed the cards together to generate the CW. Steve also showed his pocket protector CW key. You place the pocket protector in your pocket and press it against your chest to generate the CW. Inside the pocket protector are two bare wires separated by weather stripping. As the winner of the contest, Mike KF3CD was awarded a Digital Multi-Meter.
